Information on holding general PTA meetings virtually

For incorporated local units only. Expires May 13 (unless renewed by the governor). Meeting can be held by any electronic means that allows all participants to hear and participate in the meeting. Notice is required (3 or 10 days) Quorum must be met Only verified members may vote Special note – Elections Incorporation deadline – May 1 – contact state office, copy me



Guidance on Transition Period

For everyone:

Any legal requirement or bylaw cannot be enforced when the organization is not able to do it.

The organization is charged with doing "the next best thing." Boards can meet virtually – guidelines are in your bylaws

Do your best

Be transparent

Document all motions in your minutes

Ratify any relevant actions at your next in person meeting

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Guidance on Transition Period – Financial Information

Continue best practices

Transparency/Checks & Balances/Accountability
Two signatures on checks (PDF the approval, mail the checks)
Use digital signatures on approvals now, get wet signatures later
Refunds

- If paid electronically, then refund the same way

- Document everything

Guidance on donation- must be a 501(c)3 with a similar mission Do not donate "carte blanche" to the school Do not allow the school to use you to funnel refunds, donations, etc.
